5. “Bad Romance”—Lady Gaga

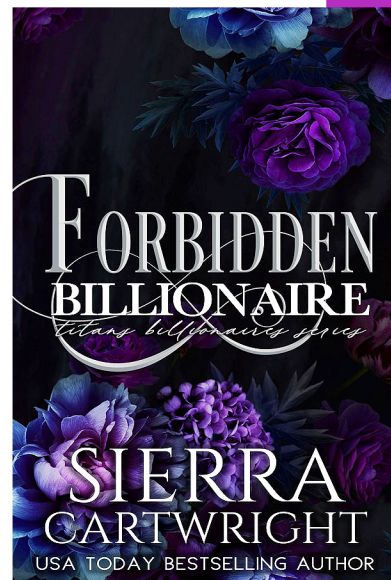
Scene: The job offer. The negotiation. The danger of working with the man who destroyed her.
